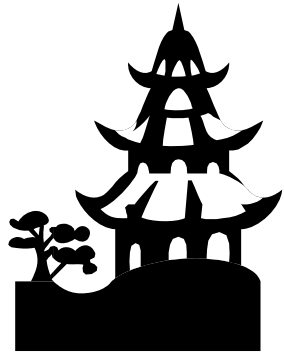

THE STORY OF BONSAI

Bonsai is a tree or plant or a group of plants grown and cultivated in a small container. The first bonsai are thought to have been grown in China around 1500 years ago. About 1200 years ago these miniature trees appeared in Japan. Since this time the Japanese have created an art form with Bonsai. The art of Bonsai has become the highest form of horticulture as a hobby. The beauty of the Bonsai lies in the shape and style of the tree and the harmony of the pot. It is a living art form and once styled, needs to be changed now and again as the tree develops and the owner sees it in a different light. The design is never finished because improvements are made as the tree grows. Over the past 40 – 50 years Bonsai has gained popularity throughout the world. There are now local, national and international Bonsai clubs helping to advance this wonderful art worldwide.
